Ranges Closed/Open During Scheduled Shoots/Events

BLACK SWAMP - Closes Cowboy Town, 300m & 500yd. Open 50m, 100m & Trap

TRAP - Closes Trap & 100m. Open 50m, 500yd, 300m & Cowboy Town

MAD MINUTE - Closes 50m, 100m & 500yd (the 100m & 500yd may be used with permission from the shoot director). Open 300m, Cowboy Town & Trap

COWBOY/WILD BUNCH - Closes Cowboy Town, 300m & 500yd (the 500yd may be used with permission from the shoot director). Open 50m, 100m & Trap

22 SILHOUETTE - Closes 100m & Trap. Open 50m, 300m, 500yd & Cowboy Range

BENCHREST CHALLENGE - Closes 300m, Cowboy Town & 500yd. Open 50m, 100m & Trap

REVERE'S RIDERS - Closes 100m, Trap & 500yd. Open 50m, 100m & Trap

CANDIDATE BIO FOR DIRECTOR SPECIAL ELECTION

Shawn Turco

I have been a dedicated member of the Club for many years. From 2016 through 2020, I served on the Board of Directors and was the Chairman for three of those years, working closely with fellow members to support programs and ensure the Club's continued success. I also am the Shoot Director for the Mad Minute Military Shoot held monthly from March through October. As a long-time member, I continue to look forward to serving the Club with integrity, collaboration, and a focus on its future.

Hunting and Land Use Rules

- 1. Hunting is permitted by members who may bring one guest under the age of 18. The guest must remain under the direct supervision of the member while hunting on club property.
- 2. Hunting may be done only during legal seasons and hours.
- 3. The woods may **only** be used from sun up to NOON on Mondays and Tuesdays all year on a first-come-first-serve basis with the ranges.
- 4. Hunters must be out of the woods by NOON, NO exceptions, other than during the three Deer Gun Seasons when ranges are closed all day. If you are inadvertently in the woods after NOON and hear the bell, exit the woods promptly. Shooters might begin shooting without knowing you are still in the woods.
- 5. If someone is using the shooting ranges when you show up to hunt or use the woods, you are not allowed to go in to the woods. Club range and land usage is on a first-come-first-serve basis.
- 6. Hunters must park by the Trap Field near the "Hunter Parking" sign.
- 7. Sign in on the 'woods sign-in sheet' in the shed at the gate.
- 8. The light system that is mounted on the sign-in shed is controlled by a switch located on the inside of the sign-in shed. If **Green** is displayed, there should be no one in the woods. If **Red** is displayed, this indicates that someone is in the woods. **Do not shoot on the ranges**.
- 9. The light system must be used in conjunction with the flag. It is important that, if you are going in to the woods, you use the 'woods sign-in sheet', raise the red flag and switch the light to red. This lets shooters know that there is someone in the woods. Do not forget to sign out. The last person out of the woods is responsible for switching the light back to green and lowering the flag.
- 10. We have neighbors on three (3) sides of our property, so respect their rights and DO NOT TREPASS on their property. If you are not sure where the boundaries are, ask any Director or the Club President.
- 11. Members may place tree stands in the woods, but all tree stands must be marked with the member's name and the President must be notified of its location. The Club is not responsible or liable for any damage or theft done to tree stands and equipment left in the woods.
- 12. Members may harvest dead fall wood on the Club grounds.
- 13. The driving of deer is prohibited on club property.

President's Comments

Here we are again heading into those cooler months. Hunting season is going to be here before you know it, and you'll see our Hunting & Land Use Rules listed above. Please take a minute to go over that if you plan on using the property that is available to you as a member.

The Fall Gun Show & Membership Drive is going to be October 24th & 25th this year. If you are interested in getting a couple buddies together and renting tables, please contact me at the number or email on the attached flyer. Contact me sooner than later to secure your spots.

We're seeing a little bit of an increase in trash being left on the ranges again. Please do your part in picking up before you leave and keep the ranges in better shape than when you arrived.

The camera system is moving forward and equipment has been ordered. The crew will begin doing site work and getting the infrastructure in place so we can have everything up and running asap.

You may have noticed a change on the 300m range. The 100m short berm that was on the left side of the range was removed due to safety concerns and not being large enough. The material was added to the 200m short berm to build that up to a better height. The distances where you can place targets will also change. The 300m is now no closer than 200m, so if you need that 100m distance please use the 100m west of the 50m range.
