We're having on-going issues with short-shooting and incorrect target placement. There are signs posted on ranges outlining the range limitations and a good tip to follow for proper target height is as follows. If you're looking at your target thru your firearm sights and see anything else other than backstop to the left or right edge of your target, your target is **NOT** at the correct height and needs to be adjusted. If you are unsure if your target is correct reach out to one of us or ask another member at the range. It's better to ask and be wrong, than break range rules.

I hope everyone has a wonderful holiday season this year and we look forward to what next year brings.
