Ranges Closed/Open During Scheduled Shoots/Events

BLACK SWAMP - **Closes Cowboy Town, 300m & 500yd.** Open 50m, 100m & Trap

TRAP - **Closes Trap & 100m.** Open 50m, 500yd, 300m & Cowboy Town

MAD MINUTE - **Closes 50m, 100m & 500yd (the 100m & 500yd may be used with permission from the shoot director).** Open 300m, Cowboy Town & Trap

COWBOY/BLACKPOWDER/WILD BUNCH - **Closes Cowboy Town, 300m & 500yd (the 500yd may be used with permission from the shoot director).** Open 50m, 100m & Trap

22 SILHOUETTE - **Closes 100m & Trap.** Open 50m, 300m, 500yd & Cowboy Range

BENCHREST CHALLENGE - **Closes 300m, Cowboy Town & 500yd.** Open 50m, 100m & Trap

4H - **Closes Trap & 100m from 4pm and closes all other ranges from 6pm**

OTOA - **Closes all ranges**

President's Comments

Leading into the summer months, there are a couple of points we like to touch on as a reminder for the membership and those coming out to use the ranges.

- Target Placement – Please place your targets at the proper heights and ranges for whichever range you're using. There are signs posted on each range for reference. Target height is dependent on your shooting position and range, but a quick & easy way to check is your target should “cover” the backstop ensuring your projectile impacts the berm. Below is an example of a target being **too low**. Target has grass behind it instead of backstop from this standing position on the 50m.



- Clean up debris – whatever stands, targets and/or objects you bring out must be cleaned up when you are finished for the day. Anything that gets left out typically gets thrown away and causes delays when our grounds crew is mowing.
- Calendar - We're into our busy time of year and some of the ranges will be closed due to scheduled shoots or range rentals. Plan before you come out to the property. Check the club calendar on our website and make sure the range you want to use is available.
