Hunting and Land Use Rules

1. Hunting is permitted by members who may bring one guest under the age of 18. The guest must remain under the direct supervision of the member while hunting on club property.
2. Hunting may be done only during legal seasons and hours.
3. The woods may **only** be used from sun up to NOON on Mondays and Tuesdays all year on a first-come-first-serve basis with the ranges.
4. Hunters must be out of the woods by NOON, NO exceptions, other than during the three Deer Gun Seasons when ranges are closed all day. If you are inadvertently in the woods after NOON and hear the bell, exit the woods promptly. Shooters might begin shooting without knowing you are still in the woods.
5. If someone is using the shooting ranges when you show up to hunt or use the woods, you are not allowed to go in to the woods. Club range and land usage is on a first-come-first-serve basis.
6. Hunters must park by the Trap Field near the “Hunter Parking” sign.
7. Sign in on the 'woods sign-in sheet' in the shed at the gate.
8. The light system that is mounted on the sign-in shed is controlled by a switch located on the inside of the sign-in shed. If **Green** is displayed, there should be no one in the woods. If **Red** is displayed, this indicates that someone is in the woods. **Do not shoot on the ranges.**
9. The light system must be used in conjunction with the flag. It is important that, if you are going in to the woods, you use the 'woods sign-in sheet', raise the red flag and switch the light to red. This lets shooters know that there is someone in the woods. Do not forget to sign out. The last person out of the woods is responsible for switching the light back to green and lowering the flag.
10. We have neighbors on three (3) sides of our property, so respect their rights and DO NOT TRESPASS on their property. If you are not sure where the boundaries are, ask any Director or the Club President.
11. Members may place tree stands in the woods, but all tree stands must be marked with the member's name and the President must be notified of its location. The Club is not responsible or liable for any damage or theft done to tree stands and equipment left in the woods.
12. Members may harvest dead fall wood on the Club grounds.
The driving of deer is prohibited on club property.

CANDIDATES FOR BOARD OF DIRECTOR

Lance Baker:

I have been a member of Sandusky County Sportsman Club since 2012 and an NRA member since the 1980's. My name is Bill Lindhorst. I've been a member of SCSC II for about 5 1/2 years, originally joining as an associate member for trap. I joined as a full member shortly after and am now an RSO for trap and assist with 4-H. My wife and I run the kitchen at the gun shows as well. I enjoy the club and want to help where I can.

Ken Snyder:

Hi, I'm Ken Snyder. I've been a member of the Sportsman Club for twenty plus years. I am the shoot director of trap for the last fifteen years. I would appreciate your vote for board of directors.

To By Laws Committee Chair:

The Board of Directors resolves to have the By Laws Committee revisit and reword Article III Members, Section 1. Requirements for Membership, Event Associate Members, to take effect 2027 as follows:

Section as it reads now:

A single-event associate membership allows for participation of all of the shoots for only one type of chosen Sandusky County Sportsmen's Club II shooting event for the duration of the year.

- The dues for a single-event associate membership will be \$30 plus applicable taxes.
- Fees will still apply to each event.
- If the single-event associate member decides to become a full member of Sandusky County Sportsmen's Club II during that year, the \$30 will be deducted from the total cost of membership.
- If a single-event associate member wants to upgrade to a multi-event associate membership, the member should be required to pay an additional \$20 plus applicable taxes.

A multi-event associate membership allows for participation in all Sandusky County Sportsmen's Club II shooting events for the duration of the year.

- The dues for a multi-event associate membership will be \$50 plus applicable taxes.
- Fees will still apply to each event.
- If the multi-event associate member decides to become a full member of Sandusky County Sportsmen's Club II during that year, the \$50 will be deducted from the total cost of the membership.
- A \$10 refund will be applied should the multi-event associate member choose to attend our Safety Orientation at the end of the monthly General Meeting. This only applies to the \$50 multi-event associate membership.

Proposed Change:

A single-event associate membership allows for participation of all of the shoots for only one type of chosen Sandusky County Sportsmen's Club II shooting event for the duration of the year. **Effective January 1, 2027:**

- The dues for a single-event associate membership will be **\$35 (tax included)**
- Fees will still apply to each event.

- If the single-event associate member decides to become a full member of Sandusky County Sportsmen's Club II during that year, the **\$35** will be deducted from the total cost of membership.
- If a single-event associate member wants to upgrade to a multi-event associate membership, the member should be required to pay an additional \$20

A multi-event associate membership allows for participation in all Sandusky County Sportsmen's Club II shooting events for the duration of the year. **Effective January 1, 2027:**

- The dues for a multi-event associate membership will be **\$55 (tax included)**.
- Fees will still apply to each event.
- If the multi-event associate member decides to become a full member of Sandusky County Sportsmen's Club II during that year, the **\$55** will be deducted from the total cost of the membership.
- A \$10 refund will be applied should the multi-event associate member choose to attend our Safety Orientation at the end of the monthly General Meeting. This only applies to the **\$55** multi-event associate membership.

To By Laws Committee Chair:

The Board of Directors resolves to have the By Laws Committee revisit and reword Article VII. Finance, Section 1. Dues, Initiation Fee and Assessments, paragraphs 1 and 2, to take effect 2027 as follows:

Section as it reads now:

Annual dues shall be established by the membership. Dues are \$125 per year (tax included) effective January 1, 2020 and thereafter. Dues are payable on or before January 1st of each year for the following year. Members paying dues after February 28th shall be assessed a late fee as specified in the policy and procedures manual.

New members, including new military members, and former members who membership has lapsed for a period of five (5) years or more, shall be required to pay an initiation fee. The initiation fee shall be two hundred (\$200) dollars (taxes included), and any future assessments levied to club members plus applicable taxes, along with the cost of the RFID card. The first year's dues for **new** members only shall be \$125.00, taxes included, if the member is joining in the month of January. If a **new** member joins after January 31st, membership shall be prorated at 1/12 of \$125.00, taxes included, (\$10.42 or 1/12th of future dues rate if rates increase) through October. Dues for **new** members joining in November and December shall be \$125.00, taxes included, and will include membership through the following calendar year.

Proposed Change:

Annual dues shall be established by the membership. Dues are **\$135** per year (tax included) effective January 1, **2027** and thereafter. Dues are payable on or before January 1st of each year for the following year. Members paying dues after February 28th shall be assessed a late fee as specified in the policy and procedures manual.

New members, including new military members, and former members who membership has lapsed for a period of five (5) years or more, shall be required to pay an initiation fee. The initiation fee shall be two hundred (\$200) dollars (taxes included), and any future assessments levied to club members plus applicable taxes, along with the cost of the RFID card. The first year's dues for **new** members

only shall be **\$135**, taxes included, if the member is joining in the month of January. If a **new** member joins after January 31st, membership shall be prorated at 1/12 of **\$135**, taxes included, (**\$11.25** or 1/12th of future dues rate if rates increase) through October. Dues for **new** members joining in November and December shall be **\$135**, taxes included, and will include membership through the following calendar year.
